This is because of the fact that the crane is capable of being driven easily from one place to another. In addition, the cranes can be transported to various construction locations on the road since they can drive themselves and this eliminates the need for extra transport vehicles. Being able to travel on their own really lessens transport expenses at the end of the day. One drawback of a truck crane is that it is not stable enough sitting on tires alone in order to be able to lift the major loads which a hydraulic crane could handle. Hence, to be able to fix this issue, outriggers can be extended from the deck. The outriggers make use of hydraulic pressure in order to lift the truck slightly off of the ground, making it balanced and stable. Crawler cranes feature big tracks on the base of the crane. These massive tracks are similar to the ones seen on other construction equipment like backhoes and bulldozers. The tracks allow the crane to successfully move around a construction locations.
